Custom Cabinetry

All Zoom-Rooms require a cabinet that allows for easy installation and ensures the rail guides are properly placed. You may choose to have a custom cabinet made. The cabinet can be a stand-alone piece of furniture, the centerpiece for additional custom cabinetry or can be placed in an existing closet that has sufficient dimensions to fit the Zoom-Room mechanism. You may ask an Authorized Zoom-Room Dealer to build the cabinet (see www.Zoom-Room.com), or use the mill worker of your choice. We supply detailed shop drawings upon request (call us at (888) 211-1120), as well as full phone support. Always call us before starting to construct a cabinet so we can be sure your plans will accommodate the Zoom-Room unit. Only Zoom-Rooms properly installed in cabinets built to our specifications are covered under the limited warranty.

Basic Cabinet Dimensions:

Width: 5' 4" X Height: 7' 3" (up to ceiling height) X Depth: 2'

Zoom-Rooms extend to a length of 7' in front of the cabinetry.

Note that the Zoom-Room mechanism and mattress require a cabinet or wall alcove that is just 2' in depth. At this depth, the cabinet will accommodate nearly 10" of space above the headboard, in front of the bed mechanism and mattress. This space is available for a flat screen TV, bookshelves, additional storage, etc., all of which stays in place when the bed is in operation. The bottom panel or footboard that opens with the bed is a minimum

of 1' 11" high and is the width of the cabinet. It generally does not accommodate storage in front and must weigh less than 33 lbs.

Building and Installing your Zoom-Room Cabinetry

Custom cabinetry can be ordered directly through us, or by our Authorized Dealers (see www.Zoom-Room.com) or by calling 1 (888) 211-1120. We have professionals on staff who will walk you through the process and create a design to your exact specifications for no additional charge. You may also decide to have your architect or interior designer draft the design, and have either Zoom-Room or your local mill worker manufacture the cabinet. Always call us before starting to construct a cabinet so we can be sure your plans will accommodate the Zoom-Room unit. We recommend that cabinet installation be done by a Zoom-Room professionals or qualified local mill workers. For freestanding or in-wall installations, skilled carpenters should have no problem. Detailed installation instructions are included.

Custom cabinet pricing is competitive, and will depend on the design, materials used and installation requirements.

The Zoom-Room can be configured as an independent, freestanding unit. The basic Zoom-Room cabinet does not need to be fastened to the wall, although you may choose to do so.

Components:

- Pre-drilled wood frame
- Hard plastic rail guides (easily installed in cabinet or walls with proper dimensions)
- Footboard designed to allow operation on hardwood floors or low pile carpeting
- High density foam mattress
- Washable mattress cover with appropriately spaced slots for slat supports
- Beachwood slats, with support adjustments for head, neck and lower back
- Hard plastic expandable "accordion" carriage base with side rubber slat cups and plastic rollers
- Hard plastic modular chain to climb up track guides
- Wooden end dowel to keep track and base in proper position
- Wooden base support
- Straps attached to base support to keep mechanism from overreaching rail guides
- Drive shaft supports
- Steel drive shaft
- Two electric motors (110V power source required) with battery backup in case of power failure
- Infrared receiver (must be accessible for use with remote) with safety override release
- Infrared remote with child lock
